Our Reading results have improved compared to the previous year and we are now only 0.65 below the national benchmark. In reading 75% of our children are level 2 or above. Our writing results continue to improve and we are now 3.05 below the national benchmark. In writing 56% of our children are level 2 or above. Our Maths results are slightly lower than the previous year and we are 1.45 below the national benchmark. However in Maths 73% of our children are level 2 or above.

In order to improve our results next year KS1 have decided upon the following actions: Phonics booklets for FS and KS1 to encourage reading, writing and spelling both at home and at school and to compliment our daily Phonics sessions, extra catch up groups for reading, writing and maths, the introduction of a new handwriting scheme, a daily 'Number Know How' session (in addition to our daily Maths lessons) and greater emphasis on 'Talk for writing'.
